

- 1) Embrace a Stream Project – Trout Unlimited grant
 - \$10,000/ yr, up to 3 yrs. (must match amount granted by 100%. Can be volunteer hours)
 - How many TU members are in Clinton?
 - Will not be possible to meet this year's deadline in December, but we can talk about potential grant funding for next year at next meeting.
 - 2) Fire Hydrant on North Row Road, only one in area but has not been maintained for years
 - 3) Need to involve Clinton in order to fund the group. The group will call itself **Wekepeke Watershed Restoration Task Force**. It will be not formalized until Clinton joins us.
 - 4) Entire Wekepeke Watershed is of interest to the Task Force.
 - 5) Mission: Restore the ecological integrity of the Wekepeke Watershed
 - Time: 10 year-plan
 - Scientifically based, based on consensus, validation
 - 6) Get assessors information and overlay property information
 - 7) **Homework for the next meeting:** review the materials -- report and impacts catalogue (Wekepeke.rushingrivers.org); find contacts in Clinton and encourage them to join us.
 - 8) **Goals for next meeting:** prepare list of projects (actions) and identify funding sources.
